

# Star Storm Quilt Class

Come and learn how to make an amazing contemporary 5-pointed star quilt using VFW's Star Storm pattern that radiated brilliantly from the inner star. Kathy Graves will be teaching this Victoria Findlay Wolfe's Star Storm quilt in 2 part class. Our first class will be Sunday April 28th, 1-4pm focusing on fabric selection and cutting. Second class will be Sunday May 5th, 12-5 focused on sewing and assembling your Star Storm quilt. Together we will explore color and contrast which makes each star quilt unique.

## **Sunday April 28<sup>th</sup>, 1-4pm Fabric Selection & Cutting**

Bring your fabrics you have selected for your project. Unsure what to use, bring possible fabrics that we can experiment with. We will discuss and explore fabric placement, color & contrast to help your star pop. We will help you go through the design process. Store will be open to buy any additional fabric you may need.

See pattern to see yardage needed.

Bring pattern, mat, rotary cutter, pins, and scotch tape if making larger size to first class.

## **Sunday May 5th, 12-5, Sewing your quilt**

This class we will learn process of sewing each section and assembling your quilt. You should make great progress and may be close to finishing your quilt.

Bring cut out fabric with labels & pattern
